The next phase of our sticky trap workshops has arrived and we will now use prepared sticky traps in the field. In June, Russett Park's infestation area will be surveyed to detect the presence or absence of YCA. Sticky traps will be deployed in the area by the taskforce with assistance from the YCA eradication program's field team. By finding the remaining YCA, we can target known areas of YCA presence and treat those spots with bait.

Try Lacewing vine - Adenia heterophyllus

In a garden setting it needs well drained soil, grows rapidly to 3m, needs supporting tree, plenty of water, part to full sun, and has pale yellow flowers

Two Different Ant Infestations.

Kuranda residents may be confused about our current ant problems.

The Kuranda region has infestations of two completely different tramp ants, in completely different areas, being managed by completely different organisations in two different ways. Each of them poses a huge threat to our way of life and to the Wet Tropics and each of them is exceedingly difficult, costly but absolutely necessary to eradicate.

First kid on the block was the Electric Ant, tiny (think sugar ants) and slow moving and localised largely within the Kuranda township. Biosecurity Queensland is managing this infestation which was thought to be nearly under control last year but which has now reemerged. It is the subject of a media blitz, including ads on TV.

Later to arrive was the Yellow Crazy Ant (YCA), first found up here in Russett Park but active in Southern Cairns where there are huge infestations. This is a much larger and more active ant (think 3/4 the size of a green ant) which is being managed by the Wet Tropics Management Authority with the assistance of a group of volunteers from the Kuranda region. It is this YCA program which has been the subject of many columns in this paper.
