

***Rhysotoechia robertsonii* Robertsons Tuckeroo SAPINDACEAE**



**Typical height:** To 16m

**Climate:** Tropical

**Light conditions:** Part shade

**Growth habit:** Shrub to small tree, may be buttressed.

**Growing conditions:** Endemic to North East Queensland occurring in well-developed rainforest from Cooktown to Ingham at altitude 0-800m.

**Flowers:** Sept-Feb    **Fruit:** Nov-Jan

**Other:** The fruit is a food source of the Cassowary. Provides an attractive display when in fruit.
